6. PETITIONS AND DELEGATIONS

a) Rhonda Bateman - Drinking Water Source Protection Plan Update

Ms. Bateman was present to provide Council with an update regarding the Drinking Water Source Protection Plan. She provided a legislative and organizational backgrounder, noted the reporting structure, and how the Assessment Report was compiled.

Council discussed elements of the report, particularly in regards to the Gros Cap intake area and how this could be protected through the municipal Emergency Plan. Council also briefly discussed oil tank inspections and the marina, and how these would affect the Conservation Authority.

7. REPORTS OF MUNICIPAL OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES

a) Fire Chief - Update

Chief Mousseau was present to update Council regarding the Ontario Association of Fire Chiefs annual conference which he attended, discussing the workshops and the networking opportunities.

Chief Mousseau and Council then discussed the new fire pumper and the possibility of donating the old pumper to a small community in the area. Council also discussed the possibility of forest fires in the area and concerns regarding the potential burning by-law.

Reeve Madonna then offered congratulations to the volunteer firefighters on behalf of Council, noting they did an excellent job at the Fire Hall during the visit and announcement from Mr. Ignatieff May 3rd 2010.

b) Administrator - Draft Open Air Burning By-Law

The Administrator gave Council a brief verbal update regarding the draft open air burning by-law. She noted that a draft had been sent to Mr. Thorpe from the OFM for comment, but she wanted to receive input from Council regarding permits and the burning of leaves.

Council discussed briefly discussed the burning of leaves, in particular whether designated times of year would be effective. Council also discussed potential hours of burning and the permit system. The Administrator then noted that the draft would be brought to Council at the next regular meeting.
